INTRODUCTION: -

The M.Phil. Entrance Test for admission to Master of Philosophy (M.Phil.) in the subject of Clinical Psychology at Maharashtra Mental Health Institute, B.J. Medical College, Sasoon Hospital Campus, Pune for academic year 2021-22 will be conducted by the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik as per the Guidelines of Government of Maharashtra & Rehabilitation Council of India.

1. Eligibility Criteria: -

A candidate, who fulfils the following criteria shall be eligible to appear for the Entrance Test, namely: -

- I. He is a citizen of India;
- II. He is a Domicile of Maharashtra State
- II. Master of Science (M.Sc.) / Master of Arts (M.A.) in Psychology with minimum 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in U.G.C. 7-point scale (or equivalent grade in point scale wherever grading system is followed).
- III. Relaxation of 5% of marks, as from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade may be allowed for those belonging to S.C./S.T./O.B.C. (non-creamy layer) / Differently abled and other categories of Candidates as per the policy of the State Government, from time to time or for those who had obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September 1991, and thereafter criteria prescribed by the UGC from time to time. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an - 13 - equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation as stated above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace mark procedure.

2. Submission of application form: -

Candidate must submit the hard copy of the Application form with self-attested all necessary documents as prescribed by the University on or before **07/01/2022** by post or in person at the following address-

- I. The application must be highlighted as **“APPLICATION FOR M.Phil. ENTRANCE TEST 2021-22” (UDC Section)** on the top side of envelope. Incomplete applications, in any respect, shall be rejected and no complaint or queries shall be entertained in this regard, therefore, it is the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that the application is complete in all respect and is supported by necessary attachments.
- II. Reserved category candidates shall have to submit all required self-attested documents like Caste/Tribe Certificate, Validity Certificate, Non-Creamy Layer Certificate etc. as the case may be. If he/she fails to submit any document(s) then he/she will not be eligible to take benefit under that category.
- III. The admission of the Candidates for M.Phil. Degree shall be on the basis of Merit of Entrance test conducted by the University.
- IV. The in-service Candidates applying for M.Phil. program shall have to submit “No Objection Certificate” from their employer in the prescribed format (Annexure-X and XI of Direction No. 01/2020) as the case may be.
- V. Reservation policy will be followed for admission as per the existing rules of the Maharashtra Government. Five percent (5%) seats of total sanctioned intake at Institution shall be reserved for Candidates having minimum 40% benchmark disability. The Physically Disabled candidates may claim reservation by producing valid certificate to that effect issued by the competent authority.

3. Registration Fee:

Mode of Payment: - All the Candidates need to pay Entrance Test Registration fee (Non-refundable) of Rs. 2000/- for Open Category and Rs. 1000/- for reserved Category (including Differently abled) in the form of demand draft.

4. Examination Centre: -

The Entrance Exam will be conducted at Regional Centres or at Nashik City only.

5. Issuance of Admit Cards:

Admit Cards for Entrance Test appearing candidates will be made available on the University website 07 days before the examination date and will not be sent to individual by post. It shall be the responsibility of the candidate to download the Admit Card. Candidates has to come with this printout of the Admit Card at

the time of the Entrance Test. Candidates without Admit Cards will not be allowed to enter the Examination hall.

6. Identity Verification: -

In the examination hall, the Admit Card along with original of the candidate's photo identity (bearing reasonably the same name as it appears on the Admit Card) such as PAN Card / Indian Passport / Driving License / Voter's Card / Bank Passbook with Photograph/ Photo identity proof issued by a Gazetted Officer on official letterhead along with photograph / Photo identity proof issued by a People's Representative on official letterhead along with photograph / recent Identity Card issued by a recognized School / College/ Aadhaar Card/E-Aadhaar Card print with a photograph/ Photo Identity Card (of Central Govt. /PSU or State Govt. /PSU only) should be shown to the invigilator for verification. The candidate's identity will be verified with respect to his/her details on the Admit Card, in the Attendance List and requisite documents submitted. If identity of the candidate is in doubt the candidate may not be allowed to appear for the Examination.

7. Pattern and Syllabus for the Entrance Test: -

Pattern of Examination

Paper I 100 Marks	:	General Aptitude (25 MCQ each of 02 marks) & Research Methodology (25 MCQ each of 02 marks) Total 50 MCQ of 02 marks each. (This paper is compulsory and common for all the Candidates)
Paper II (100 marks)	:	Post-Graduation Syllabus i.e.MA/M.Sc. (Psychology) (50 MCQ each of 2 marks)

- I. Entrance Test shall be conducted in **offline mode** only.
- II. The Entrance Test will consist of two question papers each of 60 minutes of duration.
- III. The Syllabus of Paper- II shall be based on Post Graduate Specialization.
- IV. There will be **no negative marking** for wrong answers.
- VI. All questions are compulsory.
- VII. Re-valuation and Photocopy facility is not available and request for the same will not be accepted.
- VIII. There will be no grace marks for Entrance Test.

Language of the entrance examination shall be English only.

8. Exemption from Entrance Examination: -

Exemptions shall be given as per clause 15.1 (2) of University Direction No. 01/2020. However, the candidate who is exempted from Entrance Exam is also instructed to fill the application form and submit it with all required documents to the University.

Preparation of Merit List: -

Merit list shall be prepared of those candidates appearing for Entrance Test. The said merit list shall be used for the process of provisional admission. The Entrance test shall be qualifying test with 50% qualifying marks for Open category candidates and 45% qualifying marks for Reserved Category candidates in both the papers. The Open category candidates and Reserved Category candidates need to score minimum 50% and 45% marks respectively in both papers in combined to qualify for preparation of merit list.

Tie-Breaker

In case of equal marks in Entrance Test the following procedure shall be adopted for deciding the merit.

First level: -

The candidate with more aggregate marks (converted into percentage up to 2 decimal points) at post-graduation.

Second Level: -

The candidate with more aggregate marks (converted into percentage up to 2 decimal points) at graduation.

Third Level: -

If the tie still persists then an older candidate will be preferred over the younger candidate.

10. Selection Process: -

- I. Allotment list of the M.Phil. research Centre shall be published on the University website. The Candidate shall finalize his admission in the allotted M.Phil. Centre and submit his retention form, along with necessary documents and the notified fees of the respective centre by the state government and University, within the time schedule.
- II. The selected candidate shall join concerned research centre and take the admission for M.Phil. program as per clause 15 of Direction 01/2020.
- III. At the time of admission, the selected candidate shall pay the prescribed fees for admission and shall complete the other procedures related to his/her admission.

11. Provisional Registration Process: -

The date of the joining of the candidate at Research Centre shall be treated as Provisional date of Registration. However, the actual term of candidate shall be deemed to start from the date of approval to the Synopsis.

12. Disclaimer: -

- I. Entrance exam is only Qualifying Examination. No entrance qualified candidate can claim automatic registration for the M.Phil. program.
- II. It shall be the responsibility of the candidate to check whether he/she fulfils the eligibility conditions for the M.Phil. registration. University shall not be responsible for any lapses thereof.

13. Warning: -

In case, any candidate is found to have submitted false information or Certificate(s) etc. or is found to have concealed or withheld some information in his/her application form, then he/she shall be debarred from admission.

Any other action that may be considered appropriate by the Vice-Chancellor of the University may also be taken against him/her, which may include criminal prosecution also.

- 14. Admission Grievance Committee: -** The Admission Grievance Committee setup under the Chairmanship of the Competent Authority. It shall deal with the representations submitted by the candidate(s) related to M.Phil. admission grievances, if any.
